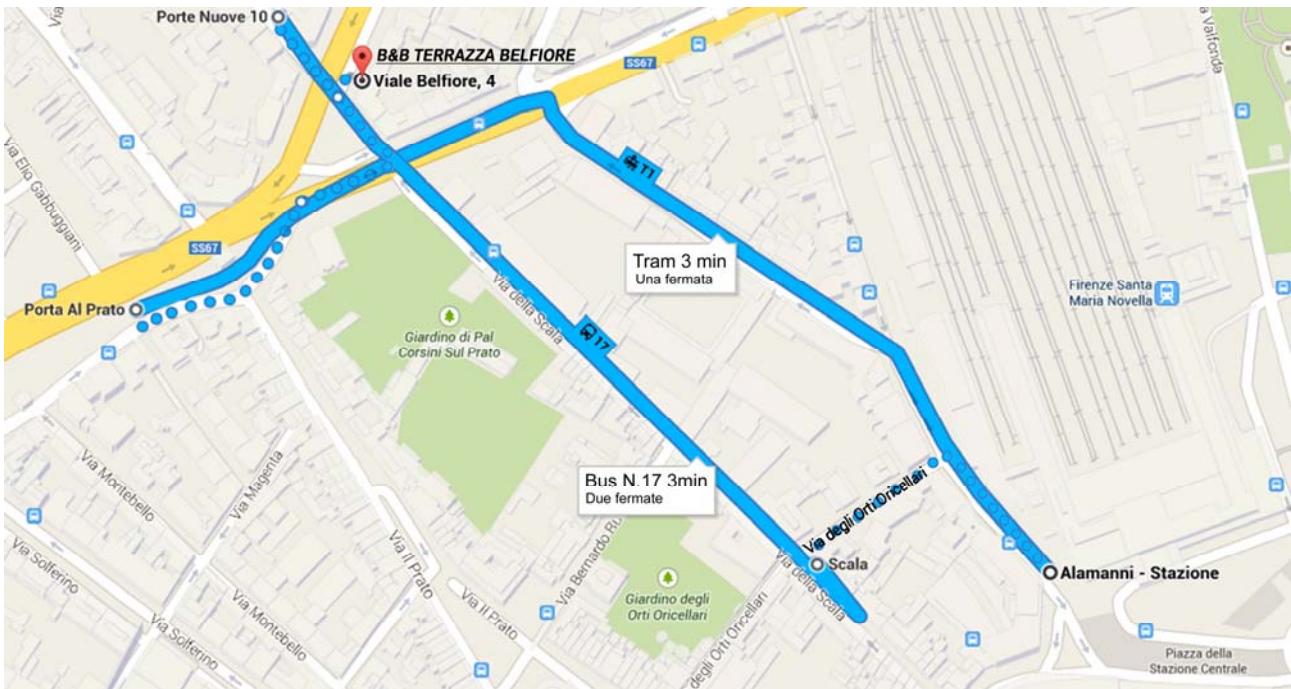


**How reach the Bed and Breakfast Terrazza Belfiore from the central train station
Santa Maria Novella by public transport**



If you want to use public transport to get here, you have two alternatives, **Tram or Bus No.17**
IF YOU USE TRAM the stop is just outside the station, just get out of the right side of the station, leaving behind you the train tracks.
 You'll find at the exit some stairs and at the end the Tram stop (ALEMANNI - STAZIONE).



Tickets can be purchased at the kiosk for 1.20 € or on board for 2.00€

You have to get off at the first stop (PORTA AL PRATO - LEOPOLDA) and go in the opposite direction of the Tram. Keep the Tram track on your left (see photo below).

The walking distance from the bus stop (PORTA AL PRATO - LEOPOLDA) to the Bed and Breakfast is approximately 250 meters.



Once you arrive in Piazzale Porta al Prato (see photo below) continue straight and go over the ancient gate located on your left.



On the other side of the square go straight on the sidewalk bordered by railings up to the first pedestrian crossing.



Once you are at the pedestrian crossing (pictured above), cross the street and on the other side (you can see at the corner a big textile shop) passed the building on the corner, turn right and you will find the entrance of our building (pictured below).



IF YOU USE THE BUS No. 17 (The walking distance from the bus stop to the Bed and Breakfast is approximately 70 meters).

Once you get out of the right side of the station, leaving behind you the train tracks (see the second photo) go ahead in the Tram direction on Via Luigi Alamanni and take the first street on the left (see photo below)



Walk along Via degli Orti Oricellari (the distance is approximately 200 meters) and turn left the first street (photo below)



Once you turn left you will find the bus stop No. 17. (Pictured below)



Get off at the second bus stop and continue for 70 meters in the opposite direction of the bus.



At the end of the road cross the street and you'll find the entrance of our building (pictured below).
